ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Eligibility:

Applicant must be a registered full-time student at an accredited post-secondary college or university. Students who are currently enrolled as well as those who have completed studies and are graduating in 2019 are eligible.

Applicant must be a registered member of one of the 40 Anishinabek First Nations.

To Apply:

Eligible students are asked to submit:

- a short bio (tell us who you are, will also be used to introduce recipient);
- □ a letter outlining academic achievements, future aspirations, and community involvement;
- □ two (2) written academic references;
- □ an official transcript of your 2018/19 grades; and
- contact information including email address, complete mailing address and phone number.

* Incomplete applications will not be considered.
